
Travelling by car – parking



There is very limited metered on-street parking (max. 2 hours) in the Assay Office's surrounding roads, with varied time restrictions and costs. If you park on the surrounding streets please check signs where you park carefully, some spaces are permit only and traffic wardens in the area are keen!

Tesco customers can use the supermarket car park for up to 3 hours. There is also unlimited on-street parking in the residential area past the entrance to the Tesco car park (Camden Street). The supermarket is located just over the dual carriageway from us. (PTO for map).

Taxis

Unfortunately a lot of taxi drivers are only familiar with our old location so please be prepared to direct them. We have found the most reliable firm in our new location is T.O.A: 0121 427 8888.

Travelling by train

The nearest station to us is the Jewellery Quarter Station and is a 10 minute walk away.

Turn right out of the station, walk along Vyse Street to the Clock Roundabout. Then turn right onto Warstone Lane, continue down the

past Gallery 54 and the Viceroy restaurant and our Public Entrance is on your left.

Snow Hill Station is 20 – 25 minute’s walk away. Follow signs in the station for the Jewellery Quarter. Turn right out of the station onto Livery Street, take the first left onto Lionel Street, then first right onto Ludgate Hill. Turn left at St Paul’s Square onto Charlotte Street, take the second right onto Newhall street, continue onto Graham Street, then Legge Lane, at the round-about go straight over onto Carver Street. Turn left at Gallery 54, continue past the Viceroy Restaurant and our entrance is on the left.

New Street Station is a 30 minute walk from our location. Take the exit onto Stephenson Street, cross the road and walk up Lower Temple Street, turn left onto New Street, take the first right up Bennett’s Hill, cross Colmore Row onto Newhall Street, continue onto Graham Street, then Legge Lane, at the round-about go straight over onto Carver Street. Turn left at Gallery 54, continue passed the Viceroy Restaurant and our entrance is on the left.

Travelling by Bus

The nearest stop to our location is the Carver Street Warstone Lane Stop (after the Jewellery Quarter Clock Stop).
